As the number of patients treated with dental implants continues to grow, the dentist and the members of the dental team are confronted with challenges of maintaining healthy peri-implant tissues around sometimes complex implant-supported restorations. Also clinicians who less involved in the active role in implant therapy meet patients who already carry dental implants. An evidence-based, team-oriented approach to supportive therapy is essential to ensure the longevity of dental implants.
